Donald Judd

One of the masters of the 20th century art, Donald Judd's solo exhibition is held at Kookje Gallery from October 30th through November 30th. Donald Judd had created unique art that turned the convention of art history around from the early 1960s till his passing in 1994.

He coined the term 'specific object' that is not either painting or sculpture through strict research and studies on materials, technique, forms, repetition and colors. In this exhibition, the audience can meet his 13 three-dimensional works and 'specific art' that he created from 1970s thru 1990s including <Untitled>(1991).

"Judd's rhetoric that deals with the question of what art is can be described as direct, indicative mood. If Judd's 'specific objects' speaks to you something in a realistic event without relying to any metaphor or symbol, it would mean that 'all existing beings are specific.' As Judd put it, the fact that something exists here, itself is amazing enough without any deduction or reasoning."
